### Inclusive History Project Co-Director of Research, Flint campus

The [Inclusive History Project](#) (IHP) is seeking a co-director of research to help lead the historical research activities of the IHP on the Flint campus and contribute to efforts to engage the Flint campus and neighboring communities in the IHP.

This is a one-year administrative appointment at 0.50 FTE with a desired start date of September 2026, with the potential for renewal depending on satisfactory performance and funding availability. If this position is renewed, this person would serve as the sole IHP director of research for the Flint campus for 2027-28. The appointment will include work over the summer, with compensation of two ninths included in the appointment.

The co-director will join the current IHP research director for the Flint campus, Dr. Lisa M. Lapeyrouse, to co-lead the research activities of the project related to the Flint campus. The newly appointed co-director will identify and lead a large-scale research project on the history of UM-Flint; support and evaluate new proposed projects from Flint faculty, staff, and students for IHP Teaching Fund grants and IHP Research & Engagement Fund mini grants; build community partnerships; and help to develop and lead programming on the Flint campus.

The co-director will work with the dedicated and dynamic IHP team on the Flint campus, partnering with Dr. Lapeyrouse, Program Coordinator Jacob Jones, the Flint IHP Advisory Committee, known as the Big Table, and a team of faculty, staff, and students working on IHP projects. They will work closely with the Genesee Historical Collections Center, help to support existing projects supported by the IHP, and build new partnerships and collaborations.

The co-director will report to IHP Co-Chair Elizabeth Cole. They will serve as a member of the IHP's Executive Committee, participate in meetings of the tri-campus IHP Advisory Committee, and help to steer the overall direction of the IHP and its next stage. The co-director will work closely with IHP Co-Chairs Elizabeth Cole and Earl Lewis, Managing Director Jenni Brady, Manager of Engagement Jennifer Junkermeier-Khan, current IHP Directors of Research Jay Cook (Ann Arbor) and Camron Amin (Dearborn), and central IHP staff who work across U-M's campuses.

The position is open to tenured and tenure-track faculty members at the University of Michigan-Flint who have deep expertise in historical research. Familiarity with the IHP is desired.

To apply, please submit 1) a current curriculum vitae; 2) names and contact information for 2 references; and 3) a 2-3 page cover letter that addresses your interest in the role, outlines your relevant experience and approach to this position, and proposes a large-scale research project on UM-Flint's history you would direct if offered this position. We strongly recommend that interested individuals discuss their interest in this opportunity with their academic unit lead in conjunction with applying.
